 - Personal transparent hand sanitizer bottle; and
 - Personal transparent water bottle.
- The Centre reserves the right to deny me entry into its premises if I do **NOT** meet any of the above requirements.

I understand that furnishing of false information or suppression of factual information or not fulfilling any of the notified criteria as well as violation of any instructions, by me, would lead to disqualification/rejection of my candidature.

ADVISORY FOR CANDIDATES REGARDING COVID-19

- Candidates who have tested Covid-19 positive recently and are in compulsory/mandatory quarantine as per the Government's guidelines/instructions, shall **NEITHER** be allowed to enter the Examination Centre **NOR** take the Examination.
- Further, if any candidate is having mild fever, cold-cough etc., he/she shall **NOT** be allowed for examination to avoid spread of COVID-19 infection.
- At the Examination Centre, candidates must follow all the physical distancing and other applicable norms as per the standard advisories issued by the Government from time to time to ensure health & safety of the candidates.
- Candidates are advised to take all necessary COVID-19 related precautions to prevent themselves from getting infected while appearing for the exam.
- Candidates must come with their face covered with mask. No entry shall be given to candidates without face mask. However, candidates will have to remove the mask for identification purpose. Candidates must keep on wearing the face mask during the entire duration of the examination.
- The candidate must bring/carry his/her own transparent hand sanitizer bottle and sanitize his/her hands before entering the Examination Centre gates and also periodically during the test as necessary.
- Thermal screening / scanning of each of the Candidates will be done at the entry point of Examination Centre for fever and **ONLY** those having normal body temperature shall be allowed to take the examination.
- Adequate measures are implemented for safety of all without compromising the standards, sanctity, and fairness in conduct of the examination. Candidates are also required to adhere to the guidelines of physical distancing, hygiene, etc. to ensure safety & health of their own and fellow candidates.
- At the time of entry, the filled in "Self-Declaration regarding COVID-19" along with the Admit Card will be checked. Candidates are required to strictly adhere to instructions provided by the centre staff.
- Candidates must reach the Examination Centre as per reporting time given in the admit card in order to avoid any crowding at the time of entry into the centre and to maintain physical distancing. Once the Examination Centre gate(s) is/are closed, no candidate will be permitted entry under any circumstances.
- Candidates will be permitted to carry only certain items with them into the Examination centre:
 - Test related documents (Admit Card, original Photo ID card, Self-Declaration regarding COVID-19, etc. Please refer Admit Card for more details)
 - Personal transparent hand sanitizer bottle; and
 - Personal transparent water bottle.
- Candidates will be denied permission to appear for examination if they violate COVID-19 directives/advisories of the Government (Central/State) applicable on the day of the test and instructions mentioned in the Admit Card. Action (which also includes disqualification from the exam, etc.) can be taken against such candidates for violations.
